MEMORANDUM TO - 1401 file

SUBJECT: Bank Sorter/Reader connection to 1401

A telephone conversation on July 22, 1858, with Mr. Copion of Poughkeopsie yielded the following information concerning a tentative set of Operation codes required for the connection of the 1401 - B-S/R.

These operation codes are a result of an earlier meeting, pardicipated in by Mr. Coplon, Mr. R. Gregory and Mr. D. Doody of Foughkeepsie, and F. O. Underwood.

The B-S/R will be designated by the address (%US). .

Data will enter the 1401 from the B-S/R buffer under control of the instruction -- L(500) (B35) R

Field definition characters will enter the 1401 as special BCD characters with word marks. Records enter in low-to-high order sequence.

The feeding mechanism of the B-S/R must be signalled to both engage and disengage by the following:

USUS E Engage B-S/R USUS D Disengage B-S/R

The thirteen pockets of the B-S/R will be designated by the thirteen siphabetic characters A thru M.

B-S/R pocket selection is then signalled by the instruction

Kd

where d is any of A thru M.

Provision must be made to test and transfer program for several conditions as follows:

T (DH- Document ready to be read T (DQ- Print buffer read

T (D)- Document in error

T(D3-T(I)*-

Dollar Amount field in error Process control field in error T(D. -Account number field in error TYDe-Transit and Route field in error

The foregoing instructions will be used for trial programming and are, therefore, subject to revision,

We expect early contact with B-S/R engineering personnel to discuss the technical details of incorporating the instructions in the machine. Note that the Bank Program is working to achieve announcement of the 1401 B-S/R attachment simultaneously with the announcement of the basic 1401 and Tape Edit System.
